## **The American Kennel Club Farm Dog Certified Test**

The test provides for a series of twelve exercises that represent situations a dog may encounter in a farm environment. The basic test requirements are designed to demonstrate a dog's trainability, self-control, confidence and trust when working in partnership with his or her owner. The test is a non-competitive pass/fail evaluation designed to assess the overall conduct of a dog. The dog must demonstrate self-control when exposed to livestock and other unique sights, sounds and scents. The dog should exhibit confidence and a willingness to comply with instructions when confronted with a variety of situations within farm type surroundings. "A wide variety of dogs live in rural areas. The FDC test is intended to demonstrate good behavior in these settings," said Alison Ruhe, AKC Executive Field Representative for Herding. "In addition, we view this class as an opportunity to benefit our herding clubs by attracting new dog owners to their events, introducing them to the fascinating sport of herding." The FDC test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program. The FDC test provides an opportunity for dogs to apply their basic training in a unique environment. One can think of it as a Canine Good Citizen test on a farm," said Doug Ljungren, V.P. for Sports & Events. "In addition to promoting responsible dog ownership, the basic manners needed for the FDC test will prepare them for many other AKC activities." ### **Notes to Exhibitors**

A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED!!

Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.

Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

Please keep your dogs on leash when not in the ring and PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!!

**Disaster and Emergency Plans for People and Dogs at this Herding Event**

**Fire: Dial 911.**

All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.

Thunderstorms and Lightning: Should lightning be observed, all personnel and animals should move or be moved to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.

**Farm Dog & Herding Instinct Tests Practices & Guidelines**

**MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY EVERYONE AT ALL TIMES**

If you refuse you will be asked to leave the Laramie County Fairgrounds without refund of **ANY** fees previously paid.

**1. Admittance to the event areas**

- a. Please be patient if there are lines.
- b. Each day you **MUST** check in at the **Main Lobby of the Archer Center** before entering **ANY** buildings or event areas on the Laramie County Fairgrounds.
- c. **EVERYONE** must initially turn in a signed **Waiver**, a **COVID Declaration/Contract Tracing** form, have your temperature checked, and receive a wristband. Forms will be available at check in but to expedite the lines, please print the forms ahead of time and have them filled out when you arrive. Forms will also be available on the CCA National website.
- d. You **MUST** wear your wristband at **ALL** times while you are on the Laramie County Fairgrounds. This signifies that you have submitted your required forms and have had your temperature checked.
- e. **EACH** day thereafter you must check in at the Main Lobby of the Archer Center again and have your temperature taken. You will receive a sticker if your temperature is within the acceptable range. You **MUST** wear this sticker in a visible place on your person at **ALL** times.
- f. If you are not wearing a wristband, you will be directed to the Main Lobby to fill out the required forms and have your temperature checked before being allowed into any building or event area.
- g. If you do not have a sticker you will be directed to the Main Lobby to have your temperature taken and receive a sticker before being allowed into any building or event area.

**NO WRISTBAND – NO STICKER – NO ADMITTANCE – NO EXCEPTION**

**2. Event Areas**

- a. **MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES** except when eating and drinking.
- b. If you are using a face shield you must also wear a face mask.
- c. If you are unable to wear a face mask for medical reasons, we are unable to alter our plans to accommodate you due to the size of the event and the burden. If you would like to enter your dog, we suggest you have a friend or a handler that can follow these guidelines run your dog.
- d. Even if you have received one or both of the COVID-19 vaccines, you must still wear a face mask.
- e. There will be a hand sanitizer station around the buildings.
- f. Consider wearing disposable gloves.
- g. Wash hands as much as possible.
- h. Avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact.
- i. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- j. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.
- k. Please consider leaving the grounds once you are done for the day.

### 3. Exhibitors

- a. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizers, hand wipes and masks.
- b. Know your run number before you go to the arena.
- c. Follow all instructions given by the gate steward for entrance to and exit from the arena and the arena area.
- d. Remember to keep the 6' social distance between you and other exhibitors.
- e. This is a self – cleaning event, please be aware of what your Collie is doing! Be prepared to clean up after your own dog.
- f. Please dispose of all used masks and gloves in **appropriate** waste receptacles.
- g. Food Trucks will be available, and you are allowed to bring your own food.
- h. **It is strongly suggested that each exhibitor have a contingency plan in place for themselves and their dogs in case of sudden illness.**

**Failure to comply with any of these practices or guidelines may result in you being asked to leave the event grounds and/or may result in a CCA Show Committee hearing and disciplinary action.**

These Practices and Guidelines are subject to change at any time based on changes to state, local, or CCA National Show Committee guidance.

## WAIVER

*If you will be at the Laramie County Fairgrounds or Rancho Terra Norte for any of the CCA Events or Activities during the Collie Club of America's Event Week, April 16 through April 25, 2021, in any capacity, you must complete this waiver prior to admittance and bring it with you to gain entry. Upon our receipt of your signed waiver you will receive your entry wrist band that you MUST wear each day that you are on the show grounds.*

### **THERE ARE NO EXCLUSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS.**

I am fully aware of the risks involved with entering the Laramie County Fairgrounds (herein, the "Fairgrounds") premises and facilities located at the Laramie County Fairgrounds, Cheyenne, Wyoming as well as any transportation and/or hotel associated with the Fairgrounds, Archer Center, the Ranch Terre Norte and/or the Collie Club of America National("CCA") (Collectively, the "Facilities") during the COVID-19 pandemic (or with respect to any related or similar infection, which together are herein referred to as "COVID-19"). I am entering into this Waiver knowingly and on my own behalf.

As a condition of my being allowed to enter the Facilities, I will fully comply with: (i) any health and safety requirements; and (ii) all local, state and federal requirements, each of (i) - (ii) as amended from time to time (collectively, the "COVID-19 Protocols"). If I test positive for COVID-19 or am exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, I agree to notify someone in charge promptly and before reentering the Facilities.

I acknowledge that the risks involved with entering the Facilities and being in the presence of other people during the COVID-19 pandemic include, but are not limited to, contracting COVID-19, respiratory failure, death, and transmitting COVID-19 to family or household members and others who may also suffer these effects. I further understand that compliance with the COVID-19 Protocols will not eliminate these risks, even with social distancing and other safety measures in place at the Facilities. Notwithstanding the foregoing, I elect to voluntarily participate in entering the Facilities with full knowledge that doing so may be hazardous to my health and those with whom I may come into contact.

I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any risks of loss or personal injury, including serious illness, injury or death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, as a result of my presence in the Facilities, whether caused by the negligence of the CCA or the Fairgrounds. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I release, waive, forever discharge responsibility and covenant not to sue the CCA, Fairgrounds, Rancho Terra Norte and their respective affiliates and each of the foregoing's respective administrators, members, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, sponsors, vendors, contractors, medical services providers, judges, superintendents or event secretary, and agents, (the "Releasees") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, illness, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees, other entities or individuals, or otherwise as a result of, or related to, my decision to enter the Facilities.

**I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREE THAT IT IS VALID FOREVER.** It is my express intent that this Waiver binds; (i) the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and (ii) my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased. I understand that this Waiver does not apply to any claim that, as a matter of law, cannot be released by private agreement.

If any of the provisions, terms or clauses of this Waiver is declared illegal, unenforceable or ineffective in a legal forum, those provisions, terms and clauses shall be deemed severable, such that all other provisions, terms and clauses of this Waiver shall remain valid and binding upon both parties.

I agree that any controversy or claim between me and any of the Releasees arising out of or relating to this Waiver or my presence at the Facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic shall be resolved by confidential, final and binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") pursuant to the Federal Arbitration Act ("FAA"). All proceedings brought pursuant to this paragraph will proceed before a single arbitrator, who shall be an experienced arbitrator licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado, take place in the County of Denver, State of Colorado, and be conducted in accordance with AAA's applicable rules. The parties agree that (i) any and all issues relating to arbitration or this arbitration clause, including, without limitation, the threshold question of arbitrability or the enforcement or validity of this arbitration clause, will be delegated to the arbitrator selected pursuant to this provision, (ii) the arbitrator will have the power to award any remedies, including, attorneys' fees and costs, available



under applicable law, (iii) judgment upon the award that the arbitrator renders may be entered in any court having jurisdiction, and (iv) the arbitrator's award may be vacated or modified only on the grounds specified in the FAA or other applicable law.

I agree that all controversies and claims between me and any of the Releasees arising out of or relating to this Waiver or my presence at the Facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic must be pursued on an individual basis only. By signing this Waiver, I waive my right to commence, or be a party to any class actions or collective claims against the Releasees.

## FACE MASK POLICY

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The Collie Club of America has adopted this policy for your protection:

According to Government sources, face masks are necessary to protect yourself and others and to prevent the spread of infectious diseases including the Covid-19 virus, according to government sources.

All attendees (ages 2 and up) are required to wear a face mask while on the event grounds. The face mask must be worn so that it covers your mouth and nose. Please bring your own face masks and **wear one at all times**. The use of a face mask is not a substitute for physical distancing. You may remove the face mask while actively eating or drinking, but you must be stationary and maintain appropriate physical distancing.

All face masks (whether disposable or reusable) must:

- Be made with at least two or more layers of washable (if not disposable), breathable fabric and not have valves or vents.
- Fully cover the nose and mouth.
- Fit snugly against the sides of your face and not have gaps.
- Be secured with ties or ear loops and allow the attendee to remain hands-free.

In Addition to:

- If using a disposable mask, it should be changed daily and disposed of properly.
- If you are using a face shield you must also wear a face mask.
- Even if you received one or both of your COVID vaccines, you must still wear a mask.
- If you are unable to wear a face mask for medical reasons, we are unable to alter our plans to accommodate you due to the size of the event and the burden. If you would like to enter your dog, we suggest you have a friend or a handler that can follow these guidelines to show your dog.

The following are not permitted:

- Neck Gaiters
- Open chin triangle bandanas
- Face masks with valves, vents, mesh material or holes of any kind.

To get the most benefits from a face mask:

- Make sure it completely covers your nose and mouth.
- Wash your hands before and after removing it. Handle only the loops or ties. Fold outside corners together.
- Try not to touch your face when you adjust it throughout the day.
- Keep cloth coverings clean by washing daily, or more often if contamination occurs.
- Don't let others wear your face mask.
- Keep it away from equipment or machinery that it could get caught in.
- If using disposable face masks, do not reuse them, and throw them away in appropriate trash receptacles.
- Don't lay your face mask on any surface that may contaminate either the covering or the surface.

As important as they are, face masks are only one source of prevention, all attendees will be required to comply with all CCA COVID-19 Attendee Protocols. The CCA COVID-19 Attendee Protocols and this Face Mask Policy are subject to change without notice.

Failure to comply with this policy may result in you being asked to leave the event grounds and/or may result in an CCA Show Committee hearing and disciplinary action.
