NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES OPEN February 1, 2023 for Rough & Smooth Collies only

- No hand delivered entries accepted
- A separate form must be submitted for each dog entered.
- Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. All fees are payable in U.S. funds.
- Express entries must waive recipient signature. If not, there is no guarantee the entry will be received in a timely manner.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.
- No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of the Collie Club of America (CCA) will be made after the closing date.
- Entry forms must be signed by the owner or owner's duly authorized agent.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Anyone owing monies to the CCA will not be able to enter and participate in any event until the debt is settled.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of CCA it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial classes, no refund will be made.
- The CCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against the CCA or any official thereof.
- After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.
- Move ups will be allowed upon competition of title requirements provided the level is not filled. Move ups must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the first run of the day.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be permitted to run. In the test classes, bitches in season will be placed at the end of the running order within the class. For trial classes, bitches in season will run in catalog order.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or otherwise restricted or confined except when being judged. No loose dogs. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

PLEASE CLEAN UP after your dog at the site and hotel. Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean, tidy condition.

MOST VERSATILE COLLIE

At the 2023 CCA National Specialty

To be eligible for this award a Collie must participate in at least three of the four AKC events offered by the CCA (Breed, Obedience/Rally, Agility or Herding). **You must sign up for this award to be eligible.** Sign up for the award at any performance event (see Beth Elliott). The sign-up sheet must be turned in to Beth Elliott by the end of the agility trial. The detailed rules for determining the winner from the Collies that qualify for the award are given below. Note that weighting factors are used in each of the performance events to recognize the difficulty of the higher level classes. In the Non-Best of Variety classes, points are awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in the class. Beth Elliott will maintain the official scores at this show. The award will be presented in the breed ring on Saturday, April 1, 2023 (time TBD).

RULES FOR MOST VERSATILE COLLIE AWARD

To be eligible for this award your Collie needs to get a qualifying score in at least three of the four events offered at the national specialty. A collie that receives MVC points in breed is considered to have received a qualifying score in that event. Only one score will be counted for each event. The collie obtaining the highest point total will win the award. The following scoring system will apply:

Breed:

- All collies that are a conformation champion or have at least 5 championship points will receive a minimum of 40 MVC points for entering and showing in a conformation class at the CCA National.
- Collies with less than 5 championship points will not automatically receive any MVC points for showing in a conformation class. Points will only be awarded for placing in a class and defeating competition.
- Since this is an individual award, brace class performance do not count. No points will be awarded to Collies entering a conformation class and not showing (i.e. marked absent).
- In the BOV class and winners competition, points will be awarded as follows:

Making no cuts	40 Points
Making first cut	50 Points
Making second cut	60 Points
Making third cut	70 Points
Award of Merit	80 Points
Select Dog or Bitch	85 Points
Reserve Winners	75 Points
Winners	80 Points
Best of Winners	85 Points
Best of Opposite to BOV	90 Points
Best of Variety	100 Points

- In all other conformation classes, points will be awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in that class as follows:

No Placement:

- 40 Points for conformation champions and collies with 5 or more CH points.
- 0 Points for collies with less than 5 CH points.

Placement:

- Two (2) additional MVC points are awarded for every dog defeated in the class up to a maximum total number of 70 MVC points.
- Collies with less than 5 CH points will also receive the base 40 MVC points for placing and defeating dogs in a class.

Herding: No points are awarded for Herding Instinct or Exhibition Only entries)

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
