All trial classes will be judged in the following order: Advanced, Intermediate and Started.
Each level will have its own handlers meeting.
Trial level runs will take precedence over test level runs. Judges will work with conflicts to ensure that everyone gets their run.

There will be a general exhibitor meeting each day at 8:30 AM followed by B duck trial handlers meeting. Judging for B ducks will begin at 9:00 AM.

A ducks and test classes will run consecutively on each day. Advanced A duck handlers meeting will start 15 minutes following the judging of B ducks. PT handlers meeting will start after the advanced A duck handlers meeting. Judging for advanced A ducks and PT will start after the PT handlers meeting. follow the judging of B ducks.

HT handlers meeting will follow PT judging.

Lunch break –Following the completion of HT. Lunch break will be 45 minutes.

Advanced A sheep handlers meeting will follow the lunch break.

JUDGING CLASS ASSIGNMENT CHANGE

To balance the judging assignments each day, the test classes on Saturday will now be judged by Karen Trimble. Test classes on Sunday will be judged by Cynthia Knowlton. All other judging assignments will remain the same.

DIRECTIONS TO ROSEHAEVEN FARM

Rosehaeven LLC, 1452 County Road 80, Alger, OH 45812

Travel on I-75 to Lima, Exit 125, toward Kenton/Lima. Turn east on Harding Hwy/OH- 309. Go 10 miles to South Hardin Rd/County Hwy-15. In one mile, turn left on County Rd 80. Trial site (Rosehaeven Farm) is 1.4 miles on the right.
